According to Ron Goldman, president of Autodesk, the product evolved out of experimentation with different user interfaces and platforms, and out of "brainstorms" the company had among its engineers. The company's aim in creating AutoCAD Product Key was to make it easier for computer users to use their computers to create drawings. Thus, the company provided an app that would allow people to use the same computer, originally a desktop, to do drafting. It also made it easy to share and revise drawings made by others. In the years since AutoCAD was first introduced, the product's user interface has not changed much. The goal, Goldman said, was to create something that would be familiar to "a professional drafter," without making the interface "overly complicated." Today, Autodesk sells AutoCAD software and licenses it to CAD users on a subscription basis. The company also sells "add-on" products, including extensions and "plug-ins," as well as third-party products that are supported by AutoCAD. AutoCAD software can be purchased for between \$80 and \$120 per year, and add-ons cost from \$50 to \$120 per year, according to the Autodesk website. Source: Autodesk First Generation AutoCAD The first generation of AutoCAD, also known as "1.0" or "drafting on the desktop," was released in December 1982, at a time when personal computer users were not accustomed to using computers for anything other than word processing. This was Autodesk's first software product, and it could only run on IBM PC-compatible computers with an internal graphics controller (with the exception of some Macintosh models). These computers, Goldman said, were "much more powerful" than they are today, with very limited memory, and with input devices such as a mouse and graphics tablet. Because there were no built-in graphics functions, a separate graphics board, or terminal, was needed to make AutoCAD work. These early-1980s computers, along with their rather limited performance, were also much more expensive than they are today. Thus, the first AutoCAD user was required to provide a graphics terminal. The user was presented with a sequence of commands that required him or her to use a mouse to position a cursor and draw lines, arcs, circles, polygons
