Two spontaneously diabetic NOD rats developed insulinitis and were insulin positive. By 20 weeks of age, 26% of non-T1D NOD rats had become diabetic. Diabetes preceded weight gain and death by at least 6 weeks, and occurred in all age and sex groups.
