Although patients can present with pain secondary to neuropathy or joints, circulatory disturbance, or vasculitis, complex regional pain syndrome (CRPS) is rarely encountered. The objective of this study was to describe the case of a patient with Behçet's disease who developed CRPS after intense inflammation and overuse. The primary care physician in this study described a 42-year-old man who presented to his primary care physician with complaints of recent-onset pain in the lower extremities. Ultrasound (US) and magnetic resonance imaging of the left knee were performed to rule out inflammation and an anterior cruciate ligament tear and showed no abnormality. The patient was placed on acetaminophen and ibuprofen. After 5 days of treatment, he reported worsening pain and developed a large, painful scrotal swelling after 2 weeks. A second opinion was sought at an emergency department where an US and MRI of the pelvis and a urinalysis were performed. The urinalysis was significant for bilirubinuria, which was diagnosed as secondary to blood transfusion. The physician returned to the emergency department for a repeat physical examination and urology consultation
